

Thursday Birder COVID-19 Protocols (Updated September 9, 2021)

Current CDC guidance states that all in high transmission areas (a status which applies to much of New Mexico) should wear masks indoors, including all who have been vaccinated. The latest evidence indicates that vaccinated individuals may, albeit rarely, contract COVID-19 and that infected individuals may be asymptomatic but transmit the virus to others.

We will continue to meet until we receive any CDC or local guidance that suggests we should not. In the meantime, we encourage you to weigh your own individual risk and make your decisions accordingly. We also strongly caution members to social distance, and to avoid carpooling unless it is with people within your immediate and limited circle of friends and relatives (your bubble).
