LOOKING AHEAD

Senator Gross, who is up for reelection in November, is one of six state senators rated 100% in their support of such legislation in the last session. (Twelve senators got zero % ratings.) Ratings were prepared by the Central Clearing House.

### BOARD MEETING

The Executive Board met at the home of Dot De Lollis on September 5 at 7:30 p.m. The following items of business were transacted:

1. President Hundertmark announced that the amendment to Article II, Section 3, making a quorum 10% of the membership, was passed.
2. The Newsletter will be published bimonthly rather than monthly.
3. Marion and Dan Washburn will be the chapter's representatives on the Audubon Wildlife Film Series Committee.
4. Marion Washburn will investigate the possibility of obtaining a non-profit organization mailing permit and rules applying to bulk mailings.
5. Air transportation to the Audubon Southwest Regional Workshop to be held in Rockport, Texas, Oct. 21 and 22, will be paid by the chapter for two representatives: Chuck Hundertmark and Jim Karo. The alternate representative is Jacque Hohlfelder. (This expenditure was approved by the membership at the September 16 meeting, when a duly authorized quorum was present.)
6. Ralph Fisher, program speaker for the September meeting, shall be reimbursed for his travel expenses to and from Silver City.
